1. Summary

1.1 The Business Support Board held its most recent meeting on the 12^{th of} May 2022. The draft minutes from this meeting are attached at **Appendix 1**. The meeting was the first held in person since inception and considered issues such as resources available in the region for publicly funded business support activity; how skills can contribute to business growth; key issues facing businesses at present; and what proactive support could be offered to support businesses through this challenging period.

The Board discussed a range of government policy changes which have impacted publicly funded business support agenda, including cut to Growth Hub budget, launch of UK Shared Prosperity Fund prospectus, the Queen Speech and the Government's Spring Statement.
