# 3. Hull and East Yorkshire Careers Hub Apprenticeship & Technical education Framework exercise

One of the key objectives of the HEY A&TE group is to increase the number of apprenticeships in the HEY region.

In addition, the Careers and Enterprise Company has an objective to promote and increase awareness of apprenticeships and technical education routeways to young people. To help with this, the CEC nationally has devised an Apprenticeship & Technical Education Framework for local stakeholders to use to self-assess strengths, weaknesses and opportunities to improve these outcomes.

Building on previous SAP commissioned research and work done by the AT&E group already on developing an action plan, group members participated in a session to work through the CEC's framework. The session was facilitated by Richard Dorney-Savage of the CEC.

The outcomes of the sessions will be used to create a map of the push and pull factors to increasing ATE participation and provide the Careers Hub with a baseline for a continued focus that will help with the development of key actions. Once complete, this exercise will be used to map our outcomes against all the Careers Hubs nationally and provide us with a comprehensive result as to how we compare regionally.

In advance of the meeting, group members were sent the Hull and East Yorkshire ATE Framework, pre-event pack and survey link to the data that was used with the meeting. Group members were asked to access the link to complete the preliminary survey.

Each Careers Hub in the country is completing an Apprenticeship and Technical Education (ATE) framework exercise and the outcome for each region will be overlaid to give a national picture. In Hull and East Yorkshire, the Careers Hub utilised the HEY A&TE working group to gain a wider perspective in relation to the above from members.

(RD-S) Provided an overview of the ATE framework and explained how this can be used as a regional self-assessment tool, the purpose being to obtain feedback on where members felt that we were as a region against the below themes:

- Employer Need.
- Employer willingness to offer an opportunity.
- Conversion rate of interest to take up.
- Promotion of ATE options.
- · Existing skills levels match requirements for next step.
- Understanding of ATE routes.
- Enthusiasm for occupation with opportunities.
- · Access to relevant training options.

Based on preliminary survey feedback, three themes were identified as key areas of focus for the HEY region:

- Employer Need.
- · Conversion rate of interest to take up.
- · Understanding of ATE routes.
